EMERGENCY DISASTER DECLARATION

WHEREAS, the Village of Cimarron in the County of Colfax in the state of New Mexico has suffered severe damage caused by the Ute Park Fire Disaster Declaration on or about Thursday, May 31, 2018 and extending until such time the emergency is over; and


WHEREAS, extensive damage was caused to Municipal operations and to homes, business, and properties; and

WHEREAS, the incident has resulted in undue suffering and hardship and threatens the safety, health, welfare, and well-being of the citizens and local economy of the Village of Cimarron, Colfax County; and

WHEREAS, all locally available public and private resources and forces available to mitigate and alleviate the damage have been insufficient to cope with the resulting situation, make repairs, and meeting public safety requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, I MAYOR LEO MARTINEZ, BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY PROVIDED BY ORDINANCE #2 AND BY THE NEW MEXICO CIVIL EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS ACT (NMSA 1978, 12-10-01 TO 12-10-11) DO HEREBY DECLARE THE VILLAGE OF CIMARRON TO BE UNDER A STATE OF EMERGENCY/DISASTER FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXERCISING NECESSARY EMERGENCY POWERS AND EXPENDITURES OF AVAILABLE LOCAL RESOURCES AND FOR REQUESTING AID, ASSISTANCE, RELIEF PROGRAMS, AND FUNDING THAT MAY BE AVILABLE FROM THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO AND PRAY THAT THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO WILL DECLARE A STATE OF EMERGENCY/DISASTER.
