All such comments so received will be considered and the Village of Cimarron will not request the release of funds or take administrative action on the project prior to the date specified in the proceeding sentence.

Release of Funds

The Village of Cimarron will undertake the activities described above with Community Development Block Grant funds under Title I from its Program Year 2018 under grant numbered <u>18-C-RS-I-01-G-22</u> from the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974. The Village of Cimarron of Colfax County is certifying to LGD and HUD that Mr. Leo Martinez in his official capacity as Mayor consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to environmental reviews, decision-making and action; and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. The legal effect of the certification is that upon its approval, the Village of Cimarron, of Colfax County may use the Block Grant funds and it will have satisfied its responsibilities under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969. LGD will accept an objection to its approval only on one or more of the bases and the procedures described in 24 CFR Part 58.75. Objections are to be addressed to the LGD/DFA, Bataan Memorial Building, Suite 202, Santa Fe, NM 87502.

Objections to the release of funds on bases other than those stated above will not be considered by the LGD/DFA. No objections received later than twenty-five (25) days after this publication will be considered by LGD.
